This uncertainty has revealed to our church body a need to have a more permanent meeting facility. We have been praying about this and searching diligently. There are many units available in the area, but the cost of a storefront rental is out of our reach as a church plant. Please join us in praying that there may be a property owner who will offer us a discounted rate. Pray for us also as we work to establish a safer and more secure church meeting place. There have been some church threat concerns in our area. We are currently working with some of our military veterans to build a security team and establish safety policies and procedures. Pray for God to give wisdom regarding this.
